WHAT DOES THE BIBLE SAY?

The LDS Church claims to be a Christian church on the basis of its name (*The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-Day Saints*) and beliefs. But the Bible says:

"Everyone who goes on ahead and does not abide in the teaching of Christ, does not have God." (2 John 1.9)

"You are from below; I am from above. You are of this world; I am not of this world."

"Whoever believes in the Son has eternal life."

MORMONISM CLAIMS:

By performing sacred Mormon rituals, men can become Gods

Satan is God's son and the spirit brother of Jesus Moses 4. *6P ch. 3

Belief in Jesus is not enough to have eternal life
